

## Lead Cast - Spring 2019

LBMP's Spring 2019 session consists of 14 weeks of classes. This includes 10 weeks of classroom rehearsals, 4 weeks of rehearsals onstage, and one weekend of performances. Classes take place once a week after school. In these weekly classes, students will learn proper stage etiquette, gain confidence, sing, act, and dance while working toward a final performance. At the end of the 14 weeks, all students perform in a full length production complete with costumes and sets.

This spring's production is ***Disney's Beauty and the Beast Jr.!***

Spring classes for students ages 8-16 are referred to as "Lead Cast" classes. At this age, all students have individual speaking roles in the final performance. They also focus on singing and dancing and they perform in group numbers throughout the final production.

In order to provide the most performance opportunities for the most children, two different casts (named Musical Notes and Top Hats) rehearse at different times and

perform in three separate shows each. The dates/times required of the different casts are indicated below. You may sign up for whichever cast you prefer.

## **Musical Notes Lead Cast**

### **Weekly Classes on Mondays 3:30pm-5:30pm (6:30pm on some weeks)**

Classroom Rehearsals: 2/11 (3:30-5:30, then parent meeting at 5:30), 2/18 (Auditions 3:30-6:30), 2/25, 3/4, 3/11, 3/18, 3/25, 4/1, 4/8, 4/15

*These classes all begin at 3:30 and run till at least 5:30pm. Beginning in the third week of class, Linda will request specific students to stay one extra hour for blocking rehearsals. In blocking rehearsals, Linda works on staging individual scenes with the students, so the characters who are required to stay will vary each week. An email will be sent out to confirm which students are needed. 6:30pm will be the end time if called for blocking rehearsals.*

Theater Rehearsals: 4/23\*, 4/29, 5/6, 5/15\* (Dress Rehearsal)

*These Theater Rehearsals are all 3:00-7:00.*

*\*Please note that 4/23 is a Tuesday and 5/15 is a Wednesday instead of Monday.*

Saturday, May 18th at 2:00 pm

Sunday, May 19th at 6:00 pm

*Students are required to be backstage one hour prior to show time.*

## **Weekly Classes on Wednesdays 3:45pm-5:30pm (6:30pm on some weeks)**

Classroom Rehearsals: 2/13 (3:45-5:30, then parent meeting at 5:30), 2/20 (Auditions 3:45-6:30), 2/27, 3/6, 3/13, 3/20, 3/27, 4/3, 4/10, 4/17

*These classes all begin at 3:45 and run till at least 5:30pm. Beginning in the third week of class, Linda will request specific students to stay one extra hour for blocking rehearsals. In blocking rehearsals, Linda works on staging individual scenes with the students, so the characters who are required to stay will vary each week. An email will be sent out to confirm which students are needed on which weeks. 6:30pm will be the end time if called for blocking rehearsals.*

Theater Rehearsals: 4/25,\* 5/1, 5/8, 5/16\* (Dress Rehearsal)

*These rehearsals are all 3:00-7:00.*

*\*Please note that 4/25 and 5/16 are Thursdays instead of Wednesdays.*

Performances: Saturday, May 18th at 6:00pm

Sunday, May 19th at 2:00pm

Monday, May 20th at 6:00pm

*Students are required to be backstage one hour prior to show time.*

**Additional information that applies to both Lead Cast classes:**

**Tuition: \$755**

Included in tuition:

Each student receives a LBMP T-shirt, show script, practice CD, cast photo, and DVD of the performance. You are welcome to purchase additional photos and DVDs. Tuition also covers the cost of the Cast Party.

**Additional requirements:**

Every family is required to commit to five hours of volunteer time, or a buyout of \$100 per family. Volunteer sign-up or buyout **MUST** be completed by April 12th, 2019. To pay buyout online, select "Purchase Volunteer Buyout or Playbill Ads" under the "Make A Payment" tab. Buyout can also be paid by personal check directly to LBMP.

Children will need to provide either black character shoes or black jazz shoes (or both). Children will also be asked to provide tights, shorts and a light-colored tank top to wear underneath costumes beginning with the dress rehearsal.
